<u>Services reporting requirements.</u>

The majority of our networks are connections built as extensions to existing electricity networks, to service developing housing, industrial and commercial properties. Our networks are under five years old and have been designed to meet the load requirements of these properties. The conclusion is that there is sufficient capacity for current and projected future demand and hence no immediate requirement for Distribution Flexibility Services in the next reporting year.

<u>Introduction</u>

Indigo Power Limited is an Independent Distribution Network Operator (IDNO). The majority of our networks are connections built as extensions to existing electricity networks, to service developing housing, industrial and commercial properties. Our networks are under five years old and have been designed to meet the load requirements of these properties.

<u>Distribution Flexibility Services and Energy Efficiency Services</u>

We have reviewed our requirements to support our networks where it is economic and efficient to do so. The conclusion is that there is sufficient capacity for current and projected future demand and hence Indigo Power Limited does not reasonably expect to procure Distribution Flexibility Services in the next reporting year.

Tendering process

It is our intention that should we require Distribution Flexibility Services (and where relevant Energy Efficiency Services) we would put in place a transparent and participatory service such as a tendering process. This would be conducted in accordance with objective, transparent and market-based procedures. It is not our intention to put this in place in the next Reporting Year.

Stakeholders' Engagement

It is our intention that should we tender for Distribution Flexibility Services we would consider how to engage stakeholders. This is not necessary in the next Reporting Year.

Detailed Quantitative Assessment

Indigo Power Limited has not identified a need for reinforcement in the short or medium term and therefore has not identified a need for a Detailed Quantitative Assessment.
